

# Choir Contract

## Expectations:

- Arrive to choir on time
- Have my folder AND a pencil with me at every class
- Have good singing posture
- Refrain from chewing gum
- Sing when I am supposed to be singing
- Save conversations for after the rehearsal
- Put everything under my desk that is not related to choir
- Speak to each other with honor and respect
- Keep hands and feet to oneself
- Uphold the expectations laid out in the student code of conduct

Since choir is an encore that your student chooses to be a part of, **I will not tolerate students who do not sing and/or disrupt the class with side conversations.**

Students should join choir because they have a desire to sing, not to socialize with their friends. If your child cannot meet the above expectations, his or her grade will be affected. Everyday children start with 100 points. If they meet the above expectations, they will leave class with 100 points. Student's daily grades are averaged for a weekly grade in eschool. Please email me with any questions.
