Weather Emergencies Over Consecutive Days*

Day 1 - No School/Instruction

Day 2 and Beyond - Asynchronous assignments will be posted based on current learning goals/targets in Seesaw or Schoology. Expectations will be communicated at the time of the weather emergency announcement.

**Severity of weather will be taken into account. Synchronous instruction may be considered in the event of extenuating circumstances and/or if weather emergencies persist. This plan may be modified at any time.*

Mr. Fulton's morning school cancellation call will explain if there will be:

- a. No school that day,
- b. Mode of instruction for the day.

Power outages and other unforeseen circumstances may ultimately impact the plan for the day. Any specific information will be communicated as warranted.

Instructional Scenarios:

No School/Instruction

Asynchronous classes run on a more informal schedule, with students accessing class materials during different hours from different locations.

Synchronous classes run in real time, with students and instructors attending together from different locations.
