Additional Important Information:

- The time frames provided above vary by age appropriateness i.e. KN lesson may be 15 minutes to 5th grade may be up to 35 minutes.
- We are rolling out the content areas slowly to give everyone time to get accustomed to this new learning environment. The schedule may change as we learn more and improve our remote learning skills.
- Your child's teacher will reach out with specific times for lessons.
- He/she will provide times when they may be available for additional help.
- Students can work on lessons at any time during the day.
- If your child is not available during the teacher's scheduled time it's okay. They will record any virtual meetings/ lessons for your child to access at any time. Obviously, for the individual reading conferences, your child must be present.
- Each school's daily announcements will be posted via Schoology, school webpage or school's Facebook page.
- If you don't have internet, you can find local hot spots in the community. Some of our district schools' internet can be accessed in your car from the parking lot. There will be more detailed information coming out soon.
- Students will be off on April 10 & 13. Remote learning will resume on April 14.
