Scholarship Tips

- **Apply early!** Be aware of deadlines! Give yourself plenty of time to collect the necessary materials to complete your application and give the guidance office and teachers at least ten days to complete recommendations, forms, and process transcripts.
- **Be organized.** Stay on top of deadlines, letters of recommendation, essay topics, transcript request, etc. by keeping files for each scholarship and sort them by their deadline.
- **Follow directions.** Pay careful attention to the instructions and do what they say. Many applicants may not be considered due to careless errors. If you have a question, ask your counselor for help or contact the scholarship sponsor.
- **Go over your application carefully.** Check your applications for typos, grammatical mistakes, and answers left blank. Make sure your handwriting is neat and legible.
- **Make copies.** Keeping copies of application materials ensures that you have all materials in case anything gets lost.
- **Reapply each year if applicable.** Many scholarships are renewable each year but you may have to complete a new application. Double-check your scholarships each year to see if you can reapply.
- **Avoid** any scholarship that you have to pay a fee or that ask for your credit card or bank account information.
