### **Final class schedules will be determined after on-site registration on June 21 & 22, 2018**

Summer school is designed to remediate students who have a grade of 55-69 in a core subject; this does not apply to elective courses. If at the end of the summer program the student has earned a grade of 70 or above, the sending school's principal **may** raise the student's grade to passing for the school year.

Summer school is designed to supplement the material presented during the school year rather than to attempt to duplicate the full year program. The student must demonstrate achievement in the summer school program equal to that expected during the regular school year.

The tuition charge is \$200 per 1-credit course for students currently attending the Cape Henlopen School District and \$300 for students who do not attend the Cape Henlopen School District. **Payment must be**

**made in full upon registration. Only cash, certified check, or money orders will be accepted.**

**Scholarships are available to CHSD students and will be awarded based on financial need.** Attendance for all classes is mandatory. Those students missing more than two classes will not receive course credit(s). Students must complete all assignments and tests in order to receive credit. **NO REFUND** will be made for students who drop out or who are suspended for lack of attendance or other disciplinary reasons. Three infractions of the Cape Henlopen Discipline Code will result in suspension from summer school. Major infractions may result in immediate removal. The summer school discipline rules will be reviewed and distributed the first night of classes.

Parents of students enrolling will need to arrange transportation. It is the parent's responsibility to have the students arrive no more than ten minutes before the start of class and to pick up the students at the end of the class. The school building doors will only be open at the start and at the end of classes. Students are not to remain on school grounds after class, nor are they to leave the building while their classes are in session.

**Students owing debts must satisfy all debts prior to enrolling in summer school (Board Policy #230).**

**In-person registration will be conducted from 3-6 p.m. on Thursday and Friday, June 21 & 22, 2018 at the Cape Henlopen High School cafeteria.**

Registration will be handled on a first-come, first-served basis. **Non-district students must ensure that their sending school principal will accept the summer school credits generated.** A full refund will be made if lack of enrollment restricts class offerings, or if instructors for specific courses are not available. All fees must be paid in order for credit to be awarded. Summer school courses will begin Monday, June 25, 2018.

\*Courses will be offered through Edmentum Courseware. Edmentum Courseware is a standards-based online learning program grounded in a tradition of solid research, sound pedagogy, and applied innovation. Edmentum Courseware provides courses in a wide range of core subjects, electives, and world languages. Courses consist of integrated assessments; including exemptive pretests that allow learners to forgo content they have already mastered and focus on the concepts that need additional work. Course-level assessments also include tests for each course module to ensure concept mastery.
